Project Background

In 2011 Fremont County in conjunction with the Western Greater Yellowstone Consortium (WGYC) was awarded a highly competitive, \$1.5 million dollar Sustainable Communities Regional Planning Grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The WGYC includes Fremont, Madison, and Teton Counties in Idaho as well as Teton County, Wyoming, the cities of Driggs, Victor, Ashton, Island Park, St. Anthony, Rexburg, Town of Jackson, WY, local representatives from the BLM and USFS and the non-profit Yellowstone Business partnership.

Funding from the grant has been allocated for several regional studies including development of a model land use code based off of the Greater Yellowstone Framework for Sustainable Development. The Consortium selected the cities of Victor and Driggs and Teton County, ID to be pilot project communities for the model code. As a result, planning and code consultant Code Studio of Austin, Texas is drafting a new land use code for Teton Valley. The project kicked off in November 2012 with stakeholder interviews and was followed up by a week-long open design studio, public workshops, and open houses in Victor and Driggs during Summer 2013. Conceptual zone maps were derived from the public workshops and the zones have now been matched with land use code language for public review. Outreach efforts to gather public comment and feedback on the new land use codes will continue through this summer, fall and winter.
